Applications shall be submitted entirely online at http://pgs.di.uoa.gr/outer/, until the new deadline on <u>Sunday, July 5, 2020</u>.

PDF files have an upper size limit of 2 or 3 MB. If the original documents are not in English or in Greek language, an official English translation should accompany each original document. The original (printed) documents shall be submitted by admitted students to the Secretariat at the time of registration.

Applicants should arrange for at least 2 Letters of recommendation to be sent directly by their referees. Each referee should use an official letterhead of their organization, sign the letter and send it as a PDF file by <u>5 July 2020</u> to the address: dsit_letters@di.uoa.gr, with subject line: "Letter for ApplicantLastName_ApplicantFirstName, RefereeLastName", e.g. "Letter for Smith John, Bestprofessor".

Email communications will not be acknowledged. No application will be examined unless all required documents are included in the submitted file.

Interviews may be conducted by mid-July and results shall be announced in late July. Courses start on October 1st, 2020.
